<p>Krista (Volunteer Coordinator and Activity Worker) introduced families to the computer platform called “ActivityPro” which is going to be used to manage the activity programming. More specifically, there will be an online “Family Portal” for family members to access calendars, activity reports, and photos of their resident’s participation in Recreation programming. Reports will be detailed by the number of times a resident attends programs, the types of programs they attend, 1:1 programs, and self-directed activities. Families will be able to use the portal as a window into the lives of their resident at the Pavilion. Both staff and family can update pictures to the family portal. The plan is for ActivityPro to go “live” on April 1st.</p> <p>Patience (Activity Worker) also updated families on the new evening programming that she is hosting including Creative Arts on Tuesdays, Games Night on Wednesdays, and Sewing and Knitting on Thursdays from 5:00 to 6:00 PM. Families are welcome to attend with their resident. Patience also hosts ukulele sing-alongs on the units and led the family group in an uplifting “You Are My Sunshine.”</p> <p>Shannon (Director of Resident Services) explained that the Recreation Program is introducing a Montessori approach and thereby transitioning to fewer large group activities and a focus on more individualized and small group programs rooted in residents’ personal interests and to support the five domains of cognitive, spiritual, social, physical and emotional well-being.</p> <p>Krista also shared that there will be a Spring Fling fair for all residents and their families and also volunteers and staff in the near future. More details about all the festivities to come in next month’s newsletter.</p>
